**Registered License Not Required Child Care Provider
(RLNR)**

Below are the Provincial requirements to register as a RLNR with the Child Care Resource & Referral Programs in BC. Contact your local CCRR today to inquire further about becoming a registered child care provider, and to start the process!

A RLNR child care provider is someone who may care for 2 unrelated children, in addition to their own, OR 1 sibling group, at any one time.

- Be at least 19 years of age
- Complete a Self Evaluation Form
- Complete an interview with the CCRR
- Complete a Provincial Criminal Record Review Check
- Submit 2 Character References
- Complete a First Aid course
- Undergo a Health & Safety Home Assessment
- Complete 20 hours of Family Child Care Training

RLNR Child Care Providers have access to all CCRR services including child care referrals, resources, consultations, newsletters, workshops and more! And eligible families in your care receive a higher rate of child care subsidy. Start your own home based business!
